



Historic Theatre Tours Fact Sheet

Members of the public are invited to take a walking tour of Hennepin Theatre Trust’s State, Orpheum and Pantages Theatres for an up-close look at the architecture, detailing and structure of the venues that anchored the region’s “Theatre Row” along with an overview history of the buildings. Public tours are offered the second Saturday of each month at 10 a.m. and the last Monday of the each month at 1 p.m. and last approximately one hour. Tours start at the State Theatre Box Office and cost \$5 per person. Theatre availability is determined by performance schedules at each venue. Group tours, including discounted rates for educational organizations, are also available by appointment.
